## Alcohol

### Statement of intent:

The Academy is committed to ensuring that all members of the Academy, and visitors to the Academy, understand the ill-effects that can be caused by drinking alcohol. The policy applies at all times, including evenings, weekends and holidays when in loco parentis. It also applies to lettings made by the Academy to other groups.

Alcohol may be consumed on school premises at social occasions, by adults, in order to model appropriate use. **However, where adults are supervising children, or intending to, both on and off campus, alcohol will not be consumed.**

### The aim is:

- to have in place an appropriate programme of education, based upon the best available professional advice, the aim of which is to inform every student of the potential ill-effects of alcohol and to explore the peer pressure involved in drinking alcohol and aims to combat this.

### Procedures:

Within the PSHE and science curriculum there is an active programme of education about the dangers of alcohol, in terms of damage to health.

The positive reasons for the policy are advocated at all times, including its application on field trips and all educational visits, and to supervisors, contractors, visitors and parents. If the policy is contravened, sanctions will be put in place. If these sanctions are ignored, the matter becomes a disciplinary matter for either staff or scholars involved. The student's place in the Academy may be forfeited.
