End of Year 11

You will have received the timetable for the series of assessments taking place in May. I hope all the preparation for these assessments is going well.

As a Trust, we have decided Year 11 students will finish their GCSE studies on the 28 May. From this date, students will not be required to attend school every day. However, all students will still need to be available from 7 June to 11 June. During this week, teachers may need to arrange a time for individuals to attend school and provide further evidence for the grades submitted to the exam boards. Some students that have outstanding coursework for vocational subjects will also need to attend sessions. This will be communicated individually if required.

From 21 June, there will be various workshops running to prepare students for transition to the next stage of their education. These will be communicated before students leave at the end of May. Furthermore, we will be contacting individual students to arrange meetings with appropriate careers advisors and staff. We strongly recommend your child attends the sessions relevant to their future choices.
