Enhanced Covid testing opportunity: Free PCR Covid-19 tests at school

The second PCR test have arrived in the academy today. Your child will be bringing their test home today. Please supervise your child doing this at home on Sunday evening 4 July 2021. Your child should return the completed test to the academy on Monday 5 July for the local Public Health Team to collect.

It is very important that you register your child's test so that you can receive the result. After you have completed your test, please register it at <https://test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/register-kit> call 119. The test results will be then come back to you as the parent or guardian of the child taking the test. [for under 18 only].

I have also attached a What To Do to try and assist you in registering the test.

If your child receives a positive test result for COVID-19 then your child and your household are required to self-isolate for 10 days immediately in line with the national guidance.

Many of our families may already live in an area where enhanced testing is taking place and you as family members are strongly encouraged to also undertake a PCR test even if you don't have any symptoms. On this website you can also find further information on financial support is available to low income households who are required to self-isolate.

The more cases we find early; the better chance we have at stopping it spreading. Please help to keep our school safer by participating in the testing.
