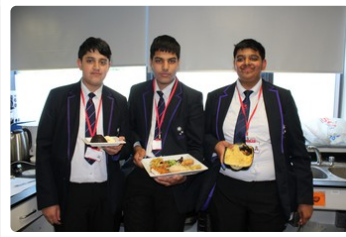
## Good News Story
