Dear Families,

As I write my final letter of this academic year, I have a great deal to reflect on from my first year as Principal of Dixons Allerton Academy. ## The new school day

I have covered this in previous letters; however, I do want to remind all families that will have new operating hours when we return in September. School will start at 8.15am every morning. School will be open to secondary students for breakfast club at 7.45am every day. School will finish at 3.30pm Monday – Thursday and at 2.35pm on Fridays.

## **Returning in September**

Students will begin returning to the academy from Wednesday 1 September. On the first day, only Year 7 students and Year 12 students will attend the academy for their induction. All students in all year groups will then be expected to attend the academy from Thursday 2 September.

#### **Equipment and Uniform**

I just wanted to remind families that we are changing our school bags to backpacks in every year group next academic year. To help with subsidising the cost of the replacement bags, we will be asking for a £10 contribution from all families. This will also cover the cost of a new 2022-23 planner and a replacement lanyard and ID card. Students will receive school bags and planners at the beginning of the new academic year. # Amendment to the behaviour policy

We aim to ensure that our students experience is as consistent and fair as possible and, as such, we will not be making any major changes to our behaviour policy; however, one change is the addition of 90-minute corrections. From September, students who are removed from class due to persistent disruption, students who miss or fail a one-hour detention and students who spend a day in RESET (e.g. Truancy or internal suspension) will receive an hour and a half correction, finishing at 5pm on Monday to Thursday and 4.05pm on a Friday. Most students will be unaffected by this and I urge these students not to become concerned with this. All changes will be reflected in our behaviour WTD on our website in September.
