Dear families,

We are so excited for the upcoming GCSE results day on Thursday 20 August. We wish all the students at DAA the very best of luck in securing their amazing outcomes so that they can continue to achieve their aspirations.

I wanted to be clear about our processes surrounding collection and next steps:

- Students will be able to collect their results from school. To allow us time to speak to students about their destinations (this information needs to be collected by the Academy) we would ask that students arrive within the following times:
- A band can collect from 9am
- D band can collect from 9:45am
- We encourage collection from the academy as we have support and guidance on site for students who may need support regarding their next steps.
- If students do not wish to collect their results, they will be available on the MCAS app from 9am.
- If a student does not have access to MCAS and cannot collect the results in person we must know in advance if anyone else is collecting on their behalf, you can do this by emailing exams@dixonsaa.com and letting us know the students name and exam candidate number and the name of the person who will be collecting them on their behalf.
- All students need to complete and sign the consent forms (access to scripts and review of results) by following this link, this makes any appeal or remark process simpler. The QR code below will take you to these.
- For students who have narrowly missed out on a grade, review will only be considered if a request has been made to exams@dixonsaa.com before 31 August 2026, any emails not sent to this address may not be considered. Once an email is received, we will only submit a review within 1 to 2 marks, we will then request the paper and our team will review the marking, only if the team confirm a review is appropriate will it be officially requested. A review can go up or down dependant on the change so you must be very careful when requesting this.
- Any request for a review of marking could take up to 6 weeks to return, please be patient
- A letter confirming whether we have applied for a review of marking will be communicated to you via email
- Once we gain any review of marking information back from the exam boards we will inform you via email
